#### **Event background**

The **green and digital transformation** is more than ever at the centre of the EU policy debate and will be key to determine **tomorrow's job market**. Rail has been a forward-looking employer across Europe over the last number of years, providing many modern high-skilled jobs. Yet many challenges remain, given that some countries will face shortages as large parts of the workforce are expected to retire in the next 10 years.
